

# Games



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## Run and touch

### How to play:

You say: 'touch something blue', 'touch a pencil', 'touch your nose', etc.

The children are running.



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## What's missing?

### How to play:

5-10 picture cards. Show all the cards. Say the words together. The children close their eyes. Remove one card.

What's missing?



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## Secret card

### How to play:

5-10 picture cards. You pick a secret card. The children ask questions in order to find the secret card.

'Is it green?', 'Does it have eyes?', etc.



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# Charades

## How to play:

A child will pick a card and mime it.

Have the class asking questions to guess the right word.



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# Stand up if...

## How to play:

You say:

‘Stand up if you like dogs.’

‘Stand up if you have a brother.’

Etc.



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# Find someone who

## How to play:

Picture cards. Find someone who likes cats, likes blue, has a sister..... Swap cards.



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# Dance and talk

## How to play:

When the music stops, find a partner and answer the question on the whiteboard.

Eg. ‘What’s your favorite animal?’

30 seconds.

Start over



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## Board race

### How to play:

Pictures on the board.  
Two teams.



You say: 'Banana'

A child from each team  
run to the board to find  
the item you said.

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## Treasure hunt

### How to play:

Hide 10 picture cards.

When someone finds a  
card they say:

'I found a....'



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## Line up

### How to play:

Maybe two teams.

Line up in numbers 1-12,  
months of the year,  
names in alphabetical  
order, etc.



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## Count to 20

### How to play:

Stand in a circle.  
Children take turns  
counting out loud, but  
only one person can say  
a number at a time. If  
not, you start over.



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# Picture dictation

## How to play:

Children draw on a piece of paper.

You say: 'draw a cat, draw 3 green apples', etc.



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# Guess who

## How to play:

Hide a picture card in your hand. Describe the picture and have the class guess what it is.



'It's big, gray and has a long 'nose' ' (elephant)

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# Odd one out

## How to play:

4 Picture cards

Eg. banana, apple, orange, dog

Ask 'Which one is the odd one out'?



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
